Game: How Many are Left?

Aim:

The goal of the game is to correctly guess how many counters are hidden. Players should be familiar with the dot patterns for numbers 1 to 10.

Equipment:

· Counters and a sheet of paper.

How to Play:

- 1. Player 1 sets up a pattern: Arrange a number of counters (1 to 10) and show them to Player 2.
- 2. Cover the counters: Player 1 hides the counters with a sheet of paper.
- 3. Change the counters Player 1 either adds or removes 1 to 3 counters.
- 4. Ask Player 2: "How many are left?"
 - If Player 2 answers correctly, swap roles.
 - If Player 2 is incorrect, repeat the process until they get it right.

Variations:

• Remove counters: Ask, "How many counters must be removed to leave 1, 2, or 3?"
